(Problem solving in mathematical concepts)

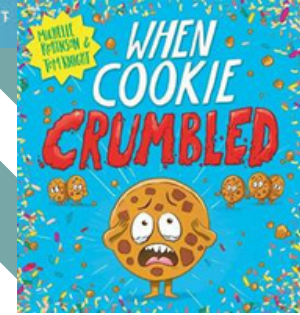
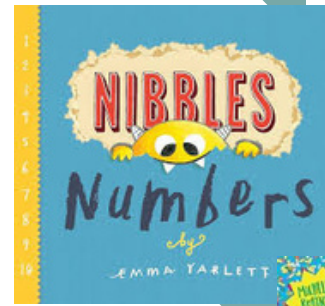


FOLLOW THE RECIPE

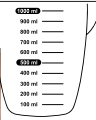
